ORDER

DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On January 9, 1991, Quest Communications Inc. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 91-16. The company later changed its name to QCC Inc. (QCC)

In a letter dated July 16, 2003, Robert Bye, Vice President and General Counsel of QCC, informed the Commission that QCC ceased operations in Oregon and requested that its certificate of authority be cancelled. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority in Oregon during 2003, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by QCC Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by QCC Inc. is cancelled.
