**DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED**

On August 20, 1999, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Wantel Inc. (Wantel) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 99-507. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that Wantel failed to respond to requests for information sent to it by the Commission on June 26, 2003, as required by OAR 860-032-0060(2). At the July 15, 2003, public meeting, the Commission determined that Wantel's certificate of authority should be canceled. Wantel's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 03-420.

On July 31, 2003, Wantel filed a request to suspend Order No. 03-420, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Wantel filed the requested information on August 5, 2003.

The information sent by Wantel to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates Wantel is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Wantel's certificate should be rescinded.

**ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 03-420 canceling the certificate of authority of Wantel Inc., is rescinded.
