ORDER

**DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED**

On March 30, 2001, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Hunter Construction Inc. (Hunter) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 01-261. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that Hunter failed to file an annual report for the year 2002 as required by OAR 860-032-0060(2)(a). On May 21, and June 27, 2003, the Commission notified Hunter that the report had not been received. At the July 15, 2003, public meeting, the Commission determined that Hunter's certificate of authority should be canceled. Hunter's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 03-435.

On August 1, 2003, Hunter filed a request to suspend Order No. 03-435, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Hunter filed the requested information on August 1, 2003.

The information sent by Hunter to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates Hunter is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Hunter's certificate should be rescinded.

**ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 03-435 canceling the certificate of authority of Hunter Construction Inc., is rescinded.
