DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On June 7, 2002, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Broadview NP Acquisition Corp. (Broadview) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 02-380. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to pay annual revenue fees to the Commission. A fee statement was sent to Broadview on February 21, 2003, and late notices were sent on April 15, May 15, and June 13, 2003. After investigation, the Commission found that Broadview failed to pay fees as required in ORS 756.310. At the July 15, 2003, public meeting, the Commission determined that Broadview's certificate of authority should be canceled. Broadview's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 03-442.

On August 11, 2003, Broadview filed a request to suspend Order No. 03-442, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Broadview paid the requested fees on August 12, 2003.

The fees sent by Broadview to the Commission were late. However, the fees have been received and indicates Broadview is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Broadview's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 03-442 canceling the certificate of authority of Broadview NP Acquisition Corp., is rescinded.
