DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On June 7, 2002, T-Netix Internet Services Inc. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 02-378.

In a letter dated September 4, 2003, T-Netix Internet Services Inc. (through its consultant, Robin Norton) requested that its authority be cancelled. The letter notes that T-Netix Internet Services Inc. has no customers in Oregon. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority in Oregon for one or more days in 2003, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by T-Netix Internet Services Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by T-Netix Internet Services Inc. is cancelled.
