The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2003, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Rural Telecom Company LLC should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Rural Telecom Company LLC is cancelled.
