DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On February 6, 2003, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Equal Access Communications LLC d/b/a Network Access (Network Access) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 03-091. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to pay annual revenue fees to the Commission. A fee statement was sent to Network Access on April 15, 2003, and a late notice was sent on May 15, 2003. After investigation, the Commission found that Network Access failed to pay fees as required in ORS 756.310. At the July 15, 2003, public meeting, the Commission determined that Network Access's certificate of authority should be canceled. Network Access's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 03-437.

On September 19, 2003, Network Access filed a request to suspend Order No. 03-437, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Network Access paid the requested fees on September 2, 2003.

The fees sent by Network Access to the Commission were late. However, the fees have been received and indicates Network Access is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Network Access's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 03-437 canceling the certificate of authority of Equal Access Communications LLC d/b/a Network Access is rescinded.
