SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

DISPOSITION: ORDER NO. 03-607 MODIFIED

By Order No. 03-607, entered October 10, 2003, the Commission approved requests by Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU) and Citizens' Utility Board (CUB) for payment of PacifiCorp Intervenor Funding Grants under the terms of the Intervenor Funding Agreement (IFA), which the Commission adopted in Order No. 03-388. The Order did not specify how PacifiCorp is to recover the costs of the grants from the various customer classes. Language ordering PacifiCorp to pay the Intervenor Funding Grants was also omitted from the Order. The purpose of this order is to determine how PacifiCorp is to recover the Intervenor Funding Grants from various customer classes and to order PacifiCorp to pay ICNU and CUB the Intervenor Funding Grants that were approved in Order 03-607.

Order No. 03-607 approved CUB's request for payment of \$3,788 from the PacifiCorp Issues Fund for expenses in hiring a consultant to assist CUB in examining general revenue requirement issues associated with UE 147.¹ The payment was applied to expenses incurred from an initial investigation into a general rate increase, which was eventually settled. Pursuant to Section 7.7(b) of the IFA, because the funds were used to advocate positions that represent a broad cross-section of customers instead of a particular customer class, it is appropriate for PacifiCorp to assess the grant funds against all customer classes.

ICNU's request was for payment of \$50,000 from the PacifiCorp Preauthorized Matching Grant. Pursuant to Section 7.7(b) of the IFA, the "Preauthorized Matching Grants shall be allocated and charged to industrial customers."²

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. PacifiCorp shall pay \$3,788 from the PacifiCorp Issues Fund Grant to Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon within 30 days after the receipt of this Order, and the grant shall be generally assessed to all of PacifiCorp's customer classes.
- 2. PacifiCorp shall pay \$50,000 from the PacifiCorp Preauthorized Matching Fund to Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities within 30 days after the receipt of this Order, and the grant shall be assessed to PacifiCorp's industrial customers.
