DISPOSITION: STIPULATION ADOPTED

On October 1, 2003, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon filed a complaint against Defendant. The complaint charged Defendant with two violations of law and requested a penalty of \$1000. On October 14, 2003, a copy of the complaint was served.

On November 25, 2003, the parties to this proceeding entered into a stipulation, which is attached as Appendix A.

Defendant admits committing the violation alleged in the complaint. The stipulation is adopted.

From the foregoing, it is concluded that no hearing is required. Under the terms of the stipulation, the allegations of the complaint are true, and Defendant has violated Oregon Administrative Rule(s) as alleged. Pursuant to the provisions of ORS 757.993, penalties should be assessed against Defendant under the terms and conditions of the stipulation.

Defendant has completed a training session on Oregon excavation laws with the Oregon Utility Notification Center Speakers Bureau, as specified in Paragraph 4C of the Stipulation.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Civil monetary penalties shall be assessed against Defendant in the amount of \$1000 for two violations of law.
- 2. Defendant shall pay the sum of \$100, due and payable within 30 days from the date of service of this order.
- 3. Payment of the balance of the penalties (\$900) shall be suspended, unless Defendant fails to comply with paragraph 2 above or a showing is made that Defendant has violated, within one year of the date of this order, any rules administered by the Oregon Utility Notification Center.
- 4. If Defendant has not paid the amount assessed in paragraph 2 above within 30 days from the date of service of this order, then Defendant shall pay the amount assessed in paragraph 1 above (\$1000). Such payment shall be due immediately following the expiration of the time period set out in paragraph 2 above.
