ORDER

DISPOSITION: APPLICATIONS GRANTED

Portland General Electric (PGE), Northwest Natural Gas Company (NW Natural) and Idaho Power Company (Idaho Power) separately filed requests for an extension of time in which to implement rule changes adopted in Order No. 03-550. The companies state that it has been difficult to implement the numerous changes relating to customer service during this time of the year. They explain that training has been difficult, as their respective customer service representatives are busy responding to calls related to storm related outages and increased usage during the winter heating season. PGE, NW Natural and Idaho Power seek an extension of time until April 1, 2004.

The Commission considers the requests as applications for a waiver of obligations under the new rules filed pursuant to OAR 860-021-0005. No rulemaking participant has filed any opposition to their requests. After consideration, the Commission finds the utilities' requests to be reasonable, and grants them.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Portland General Electric, Northwest Natural Gas Company and Idaho Power Company are relieved of obligations imposed by the rule changes adopted in Order No. 03-550, until April 1, 2004.
