ORDER

**DISPOSITION: COMPLAINT DISMISSED**

On July 24, 2003, Warm Springs Gaming Enterprises, dba Kah Nee Tah High Desert Resort and Casino, filed a complaint against Qwest Corporation. On February 22, 2004, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss. The parties stated that they have reached a settlement agreement.
