DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On April 19, 2002, Resort Network Services LLC was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 02-286.

In a letter received March 12, 2004, Peter Farrell of Resort Network Services LLC, informed the Commission that the company has ceased doing business in Oregon and its certificate of authority should be cancelled. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority in Oregon for one or more days in 2004, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Resort Network Services LLC should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Resort Network Services LLC is cancelled.
