## DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On December 12, 2001, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to TeleCents Communications Inc. (TeleCents) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 01-1061. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that TeleCents failed to comply with Oregon Universal Service Fund requirements per ORS 759.425. At the July 15, 2003, public meeting, the Commission determined that TeleCents's certificate of authority should be canceled. TeleCents's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 03-425.

On July 30, 2003, TeleCents filed a request to suspend Order No. 03-425, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that TeleCents filed the requested information on March 5, 2004.

The information sent by TeleCents to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates TeleCents is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of TeleCents's certificate should be rescinded.

## **ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 03-425 canceling the certificate of authority of TeleCents Communications Inc., is rescinded.
