DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On February 10, 1995, Medi-Tech Development Co. (Medi-Tech) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 95-199.

In a letter dated March 3, 2004, Mark Knudsen, CEO of Medi-Tech, informed the Commission that the company no longer provides telecommunications services and its certificate of authority should be cancelled. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2004, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Medi-Tech Development Co. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Medi-Tech Development Co. is cancelled.
