DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On April 13, 1999, First Telephone Company was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 99-269.

In a letter dated June 15, 2004, Jose Perez, President of First Telephone Company, informed the Commission that the company would no longer be providing telecommunications service in Oregon and its certificate of authority should be cancelled. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days during 2004, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by First Telephone Company should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by First Telephone Company is cancelled.
