DISPOSITION: STIPULATION ADOPTED

On October 22, 2003, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed Advice No. 03-19, proposing to replace its existing Rule L with new tariffs for Partial Requirements Service (Schedules 85 and 585). Advice No. 03-19 went into effect on December 5, 2003, subject to an investigation and hearing under ORS 757.215(4). On June 28, 2004, PGE, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Staff), SP Newsprint Co. (SP Newsprint), Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU), and the Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE) filed the Stipulation and Settlement (Stipulation) addressing issues raised during the investigation of Advice No. 03-19. The Stipulation (excluding exhibits) is attached as Appendix A, and incorporated by reference.

The Stipulation replaces Schedules 85 and 585 with Schedules 75, 76R, 575, and 576R (Schedules) and resolves all outstanding issues, including those identified in ICNU's issues list. The parties also agree that PGE will pay SP Newsprint \$106,281 to resolve the issues relating to whether a refund is due in this docket pursuant to ORS 757.215(4). The parties agree that the rates resulting from the Schedules are just and reasonable and satisfy the requirements of ORS 757.210.

The Commission has examined the Stipulation and the supporting testimony submitted by Staff and PGE. The Commission concludes that the Stipulation is the appropriate resolution in this docket.

## **ORDER**

## IT IS ORDERED that

- 1. The Stipulation and Settlement is adopted. Portland General Electric Company shall file Schedules 75, 76R, 575, and 576R in compliance with this order.
- 2. Portland General Electric Company shall file tariffs consistent with the findings and conclusions contained in this order within 10 days from the effective date of this order.
