DISPOSITION: COMPLAINT DISMISSED; DOCKET CLOSED

On May 18, 2004, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (PUC) filed a Complaint against the City of Beaverton (Defendant). The Complaint charged Defendant with one violation of Oregon Utility Notification Center rules on or about February 27, 2003. On June 14, 2004, the City of Beaverton (Defendant) filed its Answer denying the allegations in paragraph 6 of the Complaint and requesting a hearing in this matter.

On July 21, 2004, Defendant filed a letter with counsel for PUC Staff explaining why it did not violate Oregon Utility Notification Center rules; providing a summary of all the evidence it would present at hearing; and requesting that, based on Staff review of the facts and the law in this matter, the Complaint be dismissed.

On August 9, 2004, counsel for PUC Staff filed a Motion to Dismiss the Complaint based on its review of and agreement with the facts as provided by Defendant in its July 21, 2004, letter.

CONCLUSIONS

From the foregoing, it is concluded that no hearing is required, and Staff's Motion to Dismiss the Complaint against the City of Beaverton, filed on August 9, 2004, for one violation of Oregon Utility Notification Center rules, should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the Complaint against the City of Beaverton is dismissed and the docket is closed.
