**DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED**

On January 10, 2003, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Quality Telephone Inc. (Quality) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 03-020. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to pay annual revenue fees to the Commission. A fee statement was sent to Quality on April 19, 2004, and late notices were sent on May 14 and June 15, 2004. After investigation, the Commission found that Quality failed to pay fees as required in ORS 756.310. At the July 20, 2004, public meeting, the Commission determined that Quality's certificate of authority should be canceled. Quality's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 04-436.

On August 26, 2004, Quality filed a request to suspend Order No. 04-436, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Quality has complied and paid the fees.

The fees sent by Quality to the Commission were late. However, the fees have been received and indicates Quality is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Quality's certificate should be rescinded.

**ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 04-436 canceling the certificate of authority of Quality Telephone Inc., is rescinded.
