## DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On July 15, 1998, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to AllCom USA (AllCom) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 98-302. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to pay annual revenue fees to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that AllCom failed to pay the late statement penalty fee and monthly penalties fees as required in ORS 756.310, OAR 860-032-0008(1) and 860-032-0095(2)(b). On April 19, May 14, and June 15, 2004, the Commission notified the certificate holder that the required penalties were not received. At the July 20, 2004, public meeting, the Commission determined that AllCom's certificate of authority should be canceled. AllCom's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 04-450.

On August 27, 2004, AllCom filed a request to suspend Order No. 04-450, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that AllCom paid the requested fees on September 14, 2004.

The fees sent by AllCom to the Commission were late. However, the fees have been received and indicate AllCom is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of AllCom's certificate should be rescinded.

## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 04-450 canceling the certificate of authority of AllCom USA, is rescinded.
