DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On August 31, 2000, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Cooperative Communications Inc. (Cooperative) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 00-487. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to pay annual revenue fees to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that Cooperative failed to pay the late statement penalty fee as required in OAR 860-032-0095(2)(b). On April 19, May 14, and June 15, 2004, the Commission notified the certificate holder that the required penalties were not received. At the July 20, 2004, public meeting, the Commission determined that Cooperative's certificate of authority should be canceled. Cooperative's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 04-426.

On September 27, 2004, Cooperative filed a request to suspend Order No. 04-426, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Cooperative paid the requested fees on June 28, 2004.

The fees sent by Cooperative to the Commission were late. However, the fees have been received and indicate Cooperative is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Cooperative's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 04-426 canceling the certificate of authority of Cooperative Communications Inc., is rescinded.
