DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On June 11, 2003, Corban Communications Inc. (Corban) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 03-360.

In a letter to the Commission dated October 6, 2004, Henry Thomas of Corban, described the company's bankruptcy and stated that the company does not seek continued certification in Oregon. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2004, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Corban Communications Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Corban Communications Inc. is cancelled.
