DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On August 6, 2003, Motion Telecom Inc, (Motion) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 03-474.

In a letter dated December 2, 2004, Barbara Vonderheid of Motion, informed the Commission that its authority to do business in Oregon as a telecommunications provider should be cancelled effective no later than December 31, 2004. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority in Oregon for one or more days in 2004, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Motion Telecom Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Motion Telecom Inc. is cancelled.
