ORDER

DISPOSITION: COMPLAINT DISMISSED.

On November 9, 2004, Integra Telecom of Oregon, Inc. (Integra) filed a complaint alleging failure by Verizon Northwest Inc. (Verizon) to comply with the terms of the Interconnection Agreement between the parties and violation of Oregon Administrative Rules due to its failure to accept and process an order for two strands of dark fiber to an Integra end user customer. On November 18, 2004, Verizon responded that it would attempt to complete the order. On November 22, 2004, on Integra's motion, the schedule was suspended to allow the order to be filled.

Verizon installed the services that were the subject of the above-entitled complaint, and on December 16, 2004, Integra tested and accepted the services. The order has been completed. On December 20, 2004, Integra moved to withdraw this case and dismiss the complaint. The motion is granted.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the complaint is dismissed.
