DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On August 8, 2003, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) granted a certificate of authority to Prime Time Ventures, LLC (Prime Time) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 03-488. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to pay annual revenue fees to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that Prime Time failed to pay its full revenue fees for 2004, as required in ORS 756.310. Because payment of the full amount owed was not received by April 1, 2005, a 2 percent penalty per month was assessed on the difference. Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Staff) sent a request for information to Prime Time on July 18, 2005, noting August 19, 2005, as the due date in which Prime Time had to respond in order to stop the cancellation of its certificate of authority. Prime Time did not respond, and the Commission cancelled Prime Time's certificate of authority on August 23, 2005, in Order No. 05-939, as required by OAR 860-032-0008(2).

On September 15, 2005, Staff filed a request to rescind Order No. 05-939. After review of the Commission's records, Staff informed the Commission that Prime Time responded to Staff's request for information within the allotted time period, and paid the remaining outstanding revenue fees on August 16, 2005.

Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Prime Time's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 05-939 canceling the certificate of authority of Prime Time Ventures, LLC is rescinded.
