DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On December 22, 1999, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Eastern Oregon Telecom, LLC (Eastern) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 99-773. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that Eastern failed to file an annual report for the year 2004 as required by OAR 860-032-0060(2)(a). The Commission notified Eastern twice that the report had not been received. At the August 2, 2005, public meeting, the Commission determined that Eastern's certificate of authority should be canceled. Eastern's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 05-952.

On September 12, 2005, Eastern filed a request to suspend Order No. 05-952, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Eastern filed the requested information.

The information sent by Eastern to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates Eastern is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Eastern's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 05-952 canceling the certificate of authority of Eastern Oregon Telecom, LLC is rescinded.
