ORDER


DISPOSITION: PETITION WITHDRAWN; DOCKET CLOSED

On August 17, 2005, Eschelon Telecom of Oregon, Inc., and Advanced
Telcom, Inc. (collectively referred to as Petitioners) filed a petition seeking a declaratory
ruling as to whether OAR 860-016-0020 requires the filing and approval of Wholesale
Advantage Services Agreement between Eschelon and Verizon Services Corp. (Verizon).
On October 5, 2005, Verizon filed a letter requesting the Commission deny the petition as
improperly filed.

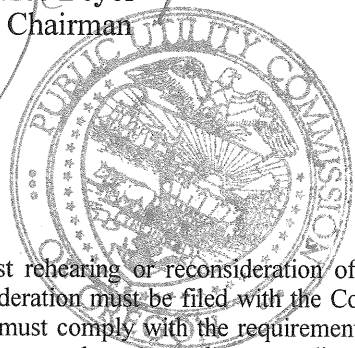
