ORDER

DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On December 10, 2003, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Bullseye Telecom Inc. (Bullseye) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 03-728. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to pay annual revenue fees to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that Bullseye failed to pay the revenue fees for 2004, as required by ORS 756.310. On June 8, 2005, the Commission notified the certificate holder that the required fees were not received. On July 12, 2005, a Fee Assessment order in docket FA 577, Order No. 05-840, was sent to the company. At the August 5, 2005, public meeting, the Commission determined that Bullseye's certificate of authority should be canceled. Bullseye's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 05-910.


On October 21, 2005, Bullseye filed a request to suspend Order No. 05-910, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Bullseye paid the requested fees.

The fees sent by Bullseye to the Commission were late. However, the fees have been received and indicate Bullseye is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Bullseye's certificate should be rescinded.


ORDER

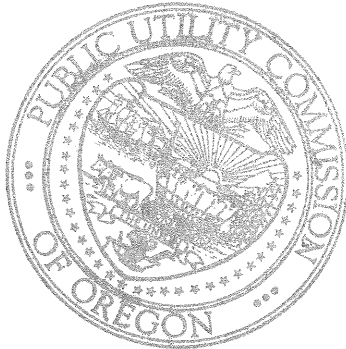
