DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On January 8, 2002, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to National Access Long Distance Inc. (NALD) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 02-013. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to pay annual revenue fees to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that NALD failed to pay the fees as required in ORS 756.310. On June 8, 2005, the Commission notified the certificate holder that the required fees were not received. On July 12, 2005, a Fee Assessment Order in docket FA 587, Order No. 05-843, was sent to NALD. At the August 2, 2005, public meeting, the Commission determined that NALD's certificate of authority should be canceled. NALD's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 05-944.

On October 26, 2005, NALD filed a request to suspend Order No. 05-944, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that NALD paid the requested fees.

The fees sent by NALD to the Commission were late. However, the fees have been received and indicate NALD is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of NALD's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 05-944 canceling the certificate of authority of National Access Long Distance Inc. is rescinded.
