DISPOSITION: ADVICE NO. 05-22 ALLOWED TO GO INTO EFFECT JANUARY 1, 2006

At its December 20, 2005, Public Meeting, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) adopted Staff's recommendation allowing Portland General Electric Company's (PGE) Advice No. 05-18 to go into effect January 1, 2006. The filing was designed to implement the energy charges and resource valuation mechanism changes that correspond to the final 2006 net variable power costs provided to the Commission in Docket No. UE 172.

The following day, on December 21, 2005, PGE filed Advice No. 05-22 to correct an administrative error made in Advice No. 05-18. PGE explains that, in the prior filing, it inadvertently failed to include the adjustment rate for Schedules 38 and 49 (although the correct figures were shown in the accompanying workpapers). PGE's new filing revises Sheet 125-3 to remedy this omission.

Because the error was inadvertent and ministerial in nature, PGE's request for a waiver of legal statutory notice is granted, and Advice No. 05-22 is allowed to go into effect on January 1, 2006.

## **ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that Advice No. 05-22, filed by Portland General Electric Company, is allowed to go into effect on less than statutory notice on January 1, 2006.
