**DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED**

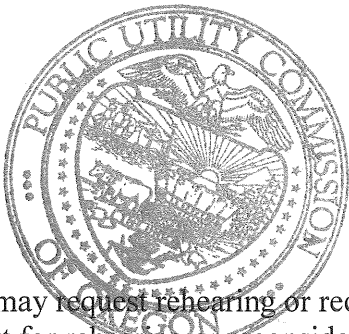
On August 6, 2003, Capsule Communications Inc. (Capsule) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 03-472.

In a letter dated March 30, 2005, Lance Steinhart, Attorney for Capsule, informed the Commission that Capsule has requested that its certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon be withdrawn. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority in Oregon for one or more days in 2005, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Capsule Communications Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Capsule Communications Inc. is cancelled.
