DISPOSITION: COMPLAINT DISMISSED; DOCKET CLOSED

The Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) reopened this docket to comply with a remand order, dated June 4, 2004, from the Marion County Circuit Court (Circuit Court).¹ The Circuit Court remanded one claim made by the Utility Reform Project, et al. (URP) in a Complaint that had been previously dismissed by the Commission.²

On November 4, 2004, a prehearing conference was held in this remand proceeding. The parties agreed to a procedural schedule that included an opportunity for URP to file an amended complaint. On November 15, 2004, URP filed an Amended Complaint.

On April 5, 2005, URP filed a Notice of Voluntary Dismissal of Complaint (Notice). The Notice indicates that URP is voluntarily dismissing the Complaint and Amended Complaint filed in this docket. We accept URP's Notice.


