**DISPOSITION: RATE SCHEDULES SUSPENDED FOR
ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF TIME**

On January 5, 2005, Shadow Wood Water Corp. (SWWC) filed a request for a general revenue requirement increase of \$19,155 in annual revenues or 78.2 percent. *See* Advice No. 05-1. At its January 25, 2005, public meeting, the Commission found good and sufficient cause to investigate the propriety and reasonableness of the rates pursuant to ORS 757.210 and 757.215. The Commission ordered suspension of the advice pending that investigation. On January 27, 2005, the Commission issued Order No. 05-056, suspending Advice No. 05-1 for a six-month period of time.


The Commission will not have an opportunity to complete its investigation in this case prior to the expiration of the initial suspension period. Accordingly, the suspension should be extended for an additional period not exceeding three months pursuant to ORS 757.215(1).

ORDER


IT IS ORDERED that Advice No. 05-1 filed by Shadow Wood Water Company Corp. on January 5, 2005, is suspended for an additional period of not more than three months beyond the last day of the initial suspension period set forth in Order No. 05-056.
