## DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On March 16, 1998, Western CLEC Corp. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 98-103.

In a letter dated July 21, 2005, Nathan Glazier, Regulatory Manager, informed the Commission that Western CLEC Corp. never commenced providing service in Oregon under its certificate of authority. He requested that its certificate of authority be cancelled. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2005, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Western CLEC Corp. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Western CLEC Corp. is cancelled.
