DISPOSITION: MONTHLY BASE RATE CORRECTED

In Order No. 05-810, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) adopted a stipulation that established new water rates for the Cline Butte Utility Company (Company). Schedule No. 4 of the adopted tariffs (Appendix A, Page 13) shows the monthly irrigation base rates for various service meter sizes. This schedule shows that a 2-inch meter has a monthly base rate of \$18.25. The rates became effective July 1, 2005.

On July 27, 2005, Company submitted a corrected Schedule No. 4, stating that the 2-inch monthly base rate should have been \$48.25, not \$18.25. A review of the testimony submitted with the stipulation is consistent with the Company's corrected schedule, and establishes that the parties agreed to 2-inch monthly base rate of \$48.25. *See* Staff 1/Sloan/6 and Staff 2/Sloan/5.

Based on this testimony, the 2-inch monthly base rate was incorrectly stated in our prior order. Attached to this erratum order is a corrected copy of Schedule No. 4, which is marked as Appendix A and incorporated herein. As it appears that a typographical error occured, we hold that that this order should be issued nunc pro tunc, with the 2-inch monthly base rate to be \$48.25 as of July 1, 2005.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Schedule No. 4, attached as Appendix A and incorporated herein, is the proper schedule to be used by the Company as of July 1, 2005.
