ORDER

DISPOSITION: COMPLAINT DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE

On May 24, 2005, Central Oregon Internet (Coinet) filed a Complaint (Complaint) against Qwest Corporation (Qwest). On June 8, 2005, Qwest filed a Motion to Dismiss (Motion). On July 7, 2005, Coinet requested an extension of time in which to reply to the Qwest Motion. Coinet filed a Response on July 8, 2005.


A telephone prehearing conference was held on August 24, 2005. Coinet President, Gary Mart, appeared on behalf of Coinet. Carla M. Butler appeared on behalf of Qwest. During the conference, Coinet indicated its intention to seek damages from Qwest via the judicial system and asked for leave to withdraw its Complaint. Qwest did not oppose the Coinet request.


