DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On May 16, 2000, SBC Telecom Inc. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 00-257.

In a letter dated May 4, 2005, John W. Stephens, attorney for SBC Telecom Inc., informed the Commission that local exchange customers have been transferred to SBC Long Distance LLC and the certificate of authority for SBC Telecom Inc. should be cancelled. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in Oregon during 2005, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by SBC Telecom Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by SBC Telecom Inc. is cancelled.
