**DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED**

On December 3, 2003, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to One Eighty Networks Inc., (One Eighty) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 03-723. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that One Eighty failed to file an annual fee statement and pay its fee for the year 2004 as required by OAR 860-032-0095. The Commission notified One Eighty several times that the statement had not been received. At the August 2, 2005, public meeting, the Commission determined that One Eighty's certificate of authority should be canceled. One Eighty's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 05-943.


On October 20, 2005, One Eighty filed a request to rescind Order No. 05-943, stating that it would provide the appropriate fee statement form and agree to pay any additional late fees and penalties as required.

On December 28, 2005, One Eighty filed its 2004 Fee Statement and paid its 2004 revenue fee plus penalties. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of One Eighty's certificate should be rescinded.

**ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 05-943 canceling the certificate of authority of One Eighty Networks Inc., is rescinded.
