ORDER

**DISPOSITION: ORDER NO. 06-063 AMENDED; REMAINING PAYMENT WAIVED.**

On December 20, 2005, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) filed a complaint against Defendant. The complaint charged Defendant with one violation of law, OAR 952-001-0050, and requested a penalty of \$1,000. On December 30, 2005, a copy of the complaint was served.

Defendant filed the Stipulation on January 20, 2006, together with a payment of \$100 towards the \$200 that was to be due within 30 days of the date of the final order.


The Commission entered Order No. 06-063 on February 9, 2006, and adopted the stipulation. Order No. 06-063 also assessed civil monetary penalties against Defendant in the amount of \$1,000, required that \$200 be paid within 30 days from the date of service of the order, acknowledged the \$100 payment from Defendant, required that only the remaining balance of \$100 is due, and conditionally suspended the remaining \$800.


On February 14, 2006, the Commission learned that Defendant died in an automobile accident. Under the circumstances, the Commission waives the remaining civil monetary penalties of \$100, and permanently suspends payment of the remaining \$800.

**ORDER**

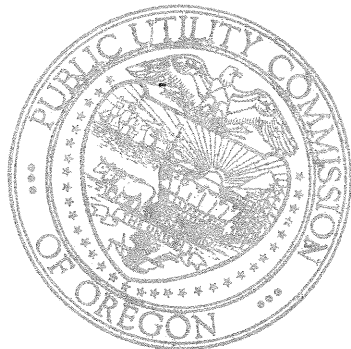
IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 06-063 be amended to state that payment of the remaining civil monetary penalties of \$100 from Defendant is waived, and the remaining balance of \$800 is permanently suspended.
