**DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED**

On July 30, 2004, Acceris Communications Corporation (Acceris) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 04-410.

In a letter dated February 14, 2006, Lance Steinhart, Attorney for Acceris, requested that the certificate of authority for Acceris be cancelled. The company has no customers in Oregon. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority in Oregon for one or more days in 2006, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Acceris Communications Corporation should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Acceris Communications Corporation is cancelled.
