SUBJECT: <u>AVISTA UTILITIES</u>: (Docket No. UG 171/Advice No. 06-01-G) Establishes Schedule 461, Income Tax Adjustment - Oregon.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

I recommend that the Commission suspend Avista Utilities' application for a new tariff schedule in Advice No. 06-01-G.

DISCUSSION:

On November 22, 2005, the Commission accepted Staff's recommendation that Avista Utilities (Avista) file an automatic adjustment clause tariff in compliance with the requirements of Senate Bill 408. This filing is in compliance with that requirement. There would be currently no rate effect for this filing. The rates are set to zero until the tax report for 2006 is filed in October of 2007.

Staff recommends the Commission suspend the tariffs for investigation. Avista, Staff and other parties are conducting workshops in Docket AR 499, which will adopt permanent rules to implement SB 408. Suspending the tariffs will enable the Commission in AR 499 to thoroughly investigate and determine how an automatic adjustment clause should be calculated. The company's proposed tariffs contain definitions and terms that have not been agreed to by the AR 499 participants or adopted by the Commission.

ORS 757.215(1) allows the Commission to suspend the proposed tariffs an additional three months if it finds the investigation will not be completed by the end of the initial sixmonth suspension period. Due to the complexity of the issues, Staff believes there is sufficient cause for the Commission to determine that the investigation cannot be

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completed within the initial suspension period, and the additional three-month suspension should be approved at this time.

PROPOSED COMMISSION MOTION:

Avista's application for new tariff schedule in Advice No. 06-01-G (UG 171), with a proposed effective date of March 8, 2006, be suspended for nine months.
