On January 17, 2006, RUNNING Y UTILITY COMPANY filed tariff sheets in Advice No. 06-6 to be effective April 1, 2006. The terms of the proposed tariff sheets are set forth in the Staff Report dated February 21, 2006, attached as the Appendix to this order.

Requests a general rate increase in the amount of \$61,976, or 20 percent.

#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Pursuant to ORS 757.215, Staff recommends the proposed tariffs filed by Running Y Utility Company (RYUC or Company) requesting a general rate increase be suspended for six months effective April 1, 2006.

#### DISCUSSION:

Running Y Utility Company provides water service to customers at Running Y Ranch Resort, located approximately nine miles west of Klamath Falls, Oregon. Customers include 443 residential, 20 commercial, 40 non-golf course irrigation, and 1 golf course irrigation.

On January 16, 2006, RYUC filed proposed tariffs with an effective date of April 1, 2006, to increase revenues by \$61,976, or 20 percent above the \$309,881 revenues collected in 2005.

RYUC states that the proposed rates would increase the average residential monthly bill from \$34.84 to \$37.77. According to the Company, the average monthly rate for a commercial customer with a 3/4 inch meter would increase from \$41.10 to \$43.50.

In its application, the Company states that increased revenues are necessary to recover increased costs of operations in order to improve profitability of the Company.

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RYUC's last rate case (UW 92) was concluded September 23, 2003, with the issuance of Order No. 03-569.

Despite this request for a six-month suspension of RYUC's proposed tariffs, Staff anticipates the analysis will be completed by mid-March. A settlement conference in this docket is scheduled for March 31, 2006.

## PROPOSED COMMISSION MOTION:

Pursuant to ORS 757.215, proposed tariffs filed by Running Y Utility Company be suspended for six months, effective April 1, 2006, to allow Staff adequate time to investigate the Company's rate proposal.

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
