DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On January 22, 1986, MCI Telecommunications Corporation was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 86-041. On September 30, 1999, the company changed its name to MCI WorldCom Network Services Inc., and again, on July 20, 2005, the company changed its name to MCI Network Services Inc.

In a letter dated February 28, 2006, Leigh Ann Cox of Verizon Business Services, requested that the Commission cancel the certificate of authority of its subsidiary MCI Network Services, Inc. ("MCINS") effective immediately. MCINS has no customers and provides no telecommunications services. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2006, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by MCI Network Services Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by MCI Network Services Inc. is cancelled.
