On December 17, 2004, Nationwide Professional Teleservices LLC was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 04-741.

The company has no customers in Oregon. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days during 2006, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Nationwide Professional Teleservices LLC should be cancelled.
