DISPOSITION: RULE AMENDED

On February 8, 2006, the Commission filed a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking Hearing and Statement of Need and Fiscal Impact with the Secretary of State. Notice was provided to certain legislators specified in ORS 183.335(1)(d) on February 6, 2006, and to all interested persons on the service lists maintained pursuant to OAR 860-011-0001 on February 21, 2006. Notice of the rulemaking was published in the *Oregon Bulletin* on March 1, 2006. No hearing was requested, and no one filed comments.

Discussion

The current rule provides that persons named on the agency's notice lists will receive notice of all rule changes, including temporary rules. This has neither been the Commission's practice, nor a requirement of Oregon law (ORS 183.335(5)). By adding the word "permanent" to OAR 860-011-0001(1)(b), interested persons would receive written notification about the adoption, amendment or repeal of any permanent rule, but not temporary rules. With this change, we preserve our maximum flexibility for adopting temporary rules.

We previously made this change in Docket AR 480. *See* Order No. 04-222. However, the word "permanent" was inadvertently deleted when we adopted the e-filing rules. *See* Order No. 04-753.

We have reviewed the proposed amendment and find that it should be adopted. The amended rule will be effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The amended rule, attached as Appendix A, is adopted.
- 2. The rule is effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.
