Requests distribution of funds associated with FERC Settlement.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Commission waive OAR 860-022-0032 and allow Portland General Electric's Advice No. 06-9, as filed on April 7, 2006, to become effective with meter readings on May 31, 2006 through June 28, 2006.

DISCUSSION:

On April 7, 2006, Portland General Electric (PGE) filed a request for approval to distribute funds associated with an Offer of Settlement resolution to FERC Docket Numbers EL02-114-000 and EL02-115-001, as well as Commission Order No. 03-599.

PGE proposes to implement a one-month credit to return to customers the balance of funds remaining from a settlement which was the result of a FERC investigation of the Company's trading activity during the western electricity crisis of 2000-01.

The "Offer of Settlement" relating to FERC Docket Numbers EL02-114-000 and EL02-115-001 require the payment of \$1.3 million to be disbursed in the following manner:

\$250,000 to Blue Heron Paper Company.

\$250,000 to Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities,

\$800,000 to be overseen by the Oregon Public Utility Commission.

Commission Order No. 03-599 mandated that \$800,000 be placed into a deferral account in January of 2004, and accrue interest at PGE's cost of capital, or 9.083 percent. The current balance as of May 31, 2006, is approximately \$990,000.

PGE proposes to distribute 43.51 percent of that balance to Residential Customers, 55.97 percent to Commercial and Industrial Customers, and 0.52 percent to Irrigation Customers. The allocation to customer classes is based on the Company's 2006 load forecast.

The credit per kWh was calculated by dividing the customer class refund amount by the forecasted customer usage for the one-month refund period. The refund rate for residential customers is 0.085 cents per kWh. For a customer using an average June amount of 739 kWh, the credit will be 63 cents.

PGE requests a waiver of OAR 860-022-0032 in order to distribute the credit with meter readings beginning on May 31, 2006, rather than with service rendered starting May 31, 2006. By basing the refund distribution on meter reading, rather than on days of service from the effective date, customers will receive their refund as a single, identifiable bill credit. Staff supports the Company's proposal for distribution as well as the Company's waiver request.

PROPOSED COMMISSION MOTION:

The Commission waive OAR 860-022-0032 and allow Portland General Electric's Advice No. 06-9, as filed on April 7, 2006, to become effective with meter readings on May 31, 2006 through June 28, 2006.
