DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On October 25, 2001, Northwest Open Access Network Oregon (Northwest Open) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 01-897.


In a letter dated May 22, 2006, Robert VanNatta informed the Commission that Northwest Open is out of business and will not be operating in Oregon. The company has no customers in Oregon. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2006, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Northwest Open Access Network Oregon should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Northwest Open Access Network Oregon is cancelled.
