DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On May 13, 2002, OCMC, Inc. (OCMC) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 02-333.

In a letter dated June 6, 2006, Margaret Good, President of the Meridian Group, informed the Commission that OCMC is no longer conducting business in Oregon. The Meridian Group has been appointed as the Receiver over the assets, property and business of OCMC. The Meridian Group is reminded that because OCMC had a certificate of authority for one or more days during 2006, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by OCMC, Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by OCMC, Inc. is cancelled.
