**DISPOSITION: TIMELINE IN ORDER NO. 05-964 AMENDED**

In Order No. 05-964, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) acknowledged Northwest Natural Gas Company's (NW Natural) 2004 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP). As a condition to the acknowledgment, the Commission requested that NW Natural file "an interim recommendation as to the public purpose charge 90 days after the Oregon Energy Trust issues its short-term demand-side assessment."

On August 8, 2006, NW Natural filed a request to increase the number of days, from 90 to 120, that the company has to file its interim recommendation. NW Natural explains that it has worked diligently with the Energy Trust and the Commission Staff, but has found that more time is needed to fully address concerns raised by Staff.

NW Natural's request is granted. The timeline in Order No 05-964 is amended to require NW Natural to file an interim recommendation 120 days after the Energy Trust issues its short-term demand assessment. The remainder of the order is unchanged.
