On December 15, 2004, Western Radio Services Company, Inc. (Western), filed a Complaint against Qwest Corporation (Qwest). On December 21, 2004, Qwest filed a Request for Extension of Time in Which to File Its Answer, which was granted by a Ruling of the Chief Administrative Law Judge that same day. Qwest filed an Answer and Affirmative Defenses on January 10, 2005.



On August 8, 2006, Western filed a letter to Administrative Law Judge Allan Arlow stating, in part, that it "withdraws its Complaint in UC 22."


ORDER

The Complaint of Western Radio Services Company, Inc., against Qwest Corporation is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE, and this docket is closed.


