DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On April 19, 2002, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Technology Services Inc. (TSI) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 02-281. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that TSI failed to file a late statement penalty and fees for 2005 as required by ORS 756.310. On May 15, and July 6, 2006, the Commission notified TSI that the penalty and fees had not been received. At the July 27, 2006, public meeting, the Commission determined that TSI's certificate of authority should be canceled. TSI's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 06-478.


On August 23, 2006, TSI filed a request to suspend Order No. 06-478, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that TSI filed the requested information and paid the required fees.

The information sent by TSI to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates TSI is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of TSI's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 06-478 canceling the certificate of authority of Technology Services Inc., is rescinded.
